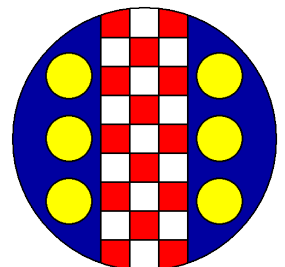
Noble Rhys Penbras ap Dafydd is our new Kingdom Exchequer. Please remember that any fundraisers need to be approved by his office.
